June 17, 2017**

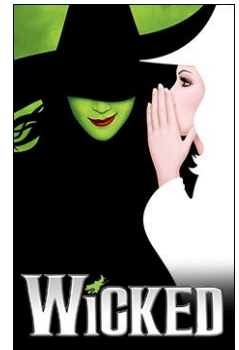


Members of the CHS Choir program have a special opportunity to sing on the stage of the Kimmel Center's Verizon Hall on Saturday, June 17!!



Who:

Pennsylvania Girlchoir (PG) and Keystone State Boychoir (KSB) perform their amazing end of year concert with world-renowned musical theatre composer Stephen Schwartz, who wrote the scores of *Wicked*, *Pippin*, *Godspell*, and more. KSB and PG are the impressive choirs that joined our Cheltenham students for a joint concert in Stretton Hall in October 2016. Their gala concert is in the Kimmel Center's Verizon Hall, one of our country's premier concert venues, and it features not only Mr. Schwartz, but also some of the best choral musicians in our region (some of whom are Cheltenham students!).

- We'll review during choir classes, and you'll practice on your own, too.

 - Wednesday, June 14, 6:00-7:30
 - At First Presbyterian Church of Germantown, 35 W. Cheltenham Ave, Phila, PA 19144.
 - Bring your music for rehearsal (though you won't use it at the concert).

On the day of the concert:

- Wear something that looks nice and professional. No shorts, jeans, or sneakers.
- Meet Ms. Hutton in the lobby of the Kimmel Center at 6:15 pm on Saturday, June 17.
- Rehearse with Mr. Schwartz and Mr. Fisher, Artistic Director of KSB, before the concert.
- Enjoy the concert, which starts at 7:30 pm. Student singers have a free ticket!
- Perform on stage with Stephen Schwartz at the end of the concert.
- The concert should end around 9:45 pm.
